## MD FUTURE CHAMPIONS WRESTLING CLINIC

OUR PROGRAM | JUNE 25 TO JUNE 29, 2012 | FOR BOYS AGES 7-18

All wrestlers will be grouped by age, weight, and skill level. Each group will learn new techniques taught by top college and high school coaches and wrestlers. Time will also be devoted to review, drilling, and live wrestling. The final afternoon session will consist of a tournament where wrestlers can test their newly learned skills.

Along with teaching great wrestling moves, each technique session will include free drilling time to give wrestlers a chance to practice new moves, and a competitive group activity to develop a sense of camaraderie and teamwork among campers. Wrestlers are encouraged to bring a pad and pen to write down any new moves learned.

### COST

The \$295 fee, which includes lunch, and a t-shirt, is due with the application. If you have to cancel for ANY reason and do so before May 1, 2012 you will receive a refund of payment, less a \$100 administrative fee. If you cancel for ANY reason after May 1, 2012 then you forfeit the entire fee. If you switch to a different program within the McDonogh Summer Programs, there will be a \$100 administrative fee.
